Public areas have been modified to adhere to social distancing guidelines set forth by the Governor.

- * Checkout stations at each side of the circulation desk

Shared Materials in the Library:

Shared headphones, phone chargers, toys, games, and puzzles will not be made available to our patrons at this time.

Newspapers will be removed at the end of the day.

Technology Help:

There will be limits on how help can be provided until social distancing recommendations are lifted. Assistance may be provided over the phone or by screen sharing. This option will be offered when possible.

Computer Use will be by appointment and limited to one (1) hour daily.

The library has new cleaning protocols.

We have increased the frequency of cleanings, paying close attention to high touch areas such as restrooms, computers, and books.

All books that are returned to the library will be cleaned and quarantined for three (3) days before being returned to circulation.

This will increase the time period before books will be available.

All items will remain on your record until we can safely check them.

All material should be returned via our book drop.
